his expanded second edition, written by experts in dental public health and pediatric dentistry, discusses children's oral health within the overall context of health promotion. It provides useful tactics for preventing the oral-health problems that most commonly affect children, including chapters on epidemiology, methods for reducing oralhealth inequalities, development of proper oral-health behaviors, public policies for healthy eating, oral-health education, and more. Each chapter is thoroughly referenced and delivers information in a variety of formats: graphs, tables, infographics, and photos. Helpful summaries and concluding statements are also provided, making it easy to focus on the key elements of each chapter. This book will be of value not only to dental public-health specialists, but to all dentists and their staff members.

It has four parts, focusing on fundamental communication skills, specific interaction skills, communication during each stage of a typical appointment, and challenging situations. Included throughout the book are exercises, discussion topics, and selftests; a checklist in each chapter summarizes the authors' recommendations.
