## Caries Detection

The product, which is painted on, contains natural hydroxyapatite-binding proteins, a linker, and a dye that binds to sites of demineralization, according to the manufacturer. Any blue color remaining after a water rinse indicates active carious lesions; the bound product can be easily removed from enamel by brushing with toothpaste.
