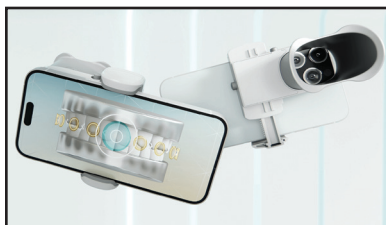

Infrared Technology

Biolux recently introduced OrthoPulse, an FDA-cleared device that uses low levels of near-infrared light to accelerate orthodontic treatment with both braces and aligners. The device stimulates the bone surrounding the roots of the tooth to help accelerate tooth movement, according to the company. The only product of its kind that uses this wavelength, it potentially shortens overall treatment time and reduces pain for orthodontic patients, while requiring fewer aligners.
