Orthodontic Toothbrush

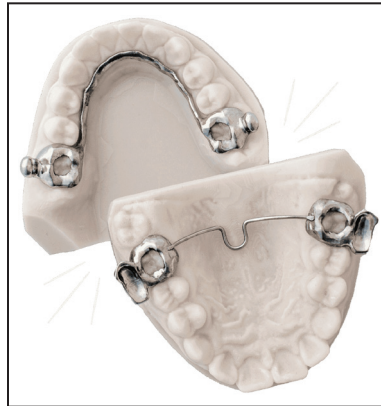

3D-Printed Trays

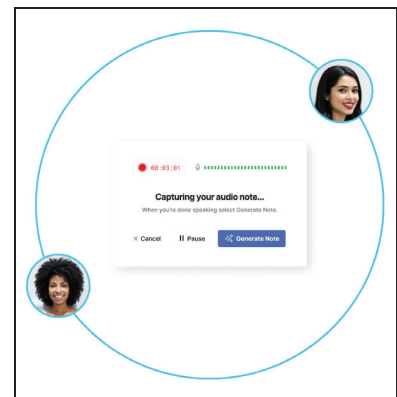
